## 2023 Carolina Clash Super Late Model Series Rookie of the Year

Eligibility Requirements & Guidelines

To qualify for the 2023 Carolina Clash Rookie of the Year Award:

- 1. The candidate must have run no more than SEVEN (7) Carolina Clash races in the 2022 season, have never won the Rookie of the Year before, have NO (0) Carolina Clash victories, and must not have won any super late model event of \$10,000 or more to win.
- 2. Rookie of the year points will be contested through-out all series events and all bonus points earned during an event will be applied to the Rookie of the Year point totals. If you are running for the Rookie of the Year Championship award, you cannot miss more than 2 races of all Carolina Clash sanctioned races held in 2023 in order to receive the award. However, if you should miss two races, you will not be eligible for regular Point Championship money.
- 3. All "Rookie of the Year" candidates must be approved for rookie status by Carolina Clash series management. Carolina Clash officials will judge each individual driver on a case by case basis to access their eligibility for the Rookie of the Year award.
- 4. Candidate must declare their intent to compete for "Rookie of the Year" on the submitted drivers information form (signed) by the NO LATER than the third race of the season and have it on file with the Carolina Clash Super Late Model Series.
- 5. All ties will be broken by number of wins by the drivers who are tied. If they have no wins, then most second-place finishes, then third, etc. will determine the tie-breaker. Points will be awarded to each rookie contender using the standard point format breakdown as used in the series point championship.
